The Park in Drumul Taberei will be named Sergiu Celibidache

Serge Ioan Celibidache was the guest of honor of the mayor, Cristian Poteraş, during the visit in the Drumul Taberei Park, which will be named after Sergiu Celibidache. Being right in the Sergiu Celibidache Square, the Sergiu Celibidache Park will be transformed by the District Hall into the biggest park belonging to District 6, the cost being covered through European funds.

The mayor, Cristian Poteraş, presented to the son of the Maestro Sergiu Celibidache the park's rehabilitation plans, an unique plan in Europe at that moment, which comprised in the complete rebuilding of the park's structure while keeping all the green spaces, and with the building of a amphitheatre with a capacity of 500 places where there will be movie projections or concerts. There will be a plant and flower glasshouse, which will be open to the public during the cold season, and, at the entrance of the park, a statue of Sergiu Celibidache will be built, that will replace the Clock in Sergiu Celibidache Square.

And, because there is the desire of the mayor Poteraş for a new identity of this area, the subway station in Drumul Taberei will be named after Sergiu Celibidache.

"First of all, I would like to thank Serge Celibidache, the son of the great Romanian conductor, for being here; he is our friend and will remain with us forever, I am convinced of that. I would say that the citizens of district 6 are the main beneficiaries because it is not just a transformation of this area. In three years, the works on the subway station will be finished, which will be named after Sergiu Celibidache, we already have the Sergiu Celibidache Square...practically, the entire area will have a new identity, literally and figuratively. Of course that, after the building of the park is finished; we will bring here a part of the cultural activities of the Sergiu Celibidache Festival, in the following years. I would like to mention the urbanistic value of this project, an aspect which is always taken into consideration by a good mayor", declared the mayor of district 6, Cristian Poteraş.
